### Real Estate CONTINUING EDUCATION Requirements

#### 2024-2026 Renewal Period

The Pennsylvania State Real Estate Commission requires each real estate sales licensee to take 14 hours of continuing education during each license renewal period.

Anyone licensed after 12/1/25 will NOT take CE for the renewal period 2024-2026.

## First time renewing real estate license in PA

New licensees (licensed after 12/1/23) who are renewing for the first time are required to complete the mandatory courses for new licensees pursuant to 49 PA Code §35.384(b). The mandatory required 14-hour CE classes are:

Mandatory: The General Module (7hrs)

PLUS, ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

Residential Module (7hrs)

or

Commercial Module (7hrs)

# NOT my first time renewing real estate license in PA

**Licensed** <u>prior</u> to 12/1/23 – The mandatory course includes a minimum of 5 (five) hours of the required 14 hours of continuing education which must be taken in a topic that covers

## 2 hours in Fair Housing and 3 hours in Agency Relationship
