Membership to the Association of REALTORS is a 3-way agreement. Therefore, all dues are paid to the local Association who then forward dues payments to the National and State Assoc. in your behalf. The 2015 dues include a \$35.00 mandatory assessment by NAR of all REALTORS® to fund a nationwide public awareness campaign.

For the year 2015, the nondeductible portions of PAR and NAR dues for income tax purposes are as follows: PAR: Of the \$130 per member dues, 9% or \$11.70 is nondeductible by members for income tax purposes. NAR: Of the \$120 per member dues, 37% or \$44 is nondeductible by members for income tax purposes. The \$35 Public Awareness assessment is fully deductible.

ANY DUES NOT PAID BY DECEMBER 31 WILL INCUR A \$50 LATE FEE ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 10 SECTION 4 OF THE BYLAWS WHICH PROVIDES THAT ALL DUES ARE DUE AND PAYABLE ON JANUARY 1ST.




